Tickets: We are unable to tell the number of tickets each student will receive until we know exactly how many students will indeed graduate each year. This cannot be determined until near the end of the school year as we have to wait on final grades to be posted. We will share with students either via face to face group meetings or Remind a number of tickets that we anticipate they can plan to receive. Please be reminded that no one is allowed to enter the graduation ceremony without a ticket. This does mean that anyone, baby to grandparent, will need a ticket. We ask students to let us know if they do not need their ticket(s) and if they request more. We cannot always accommodate, but we do try. Students that attempt to sell or do sell extra tickets will be punished and might not be able to participate in the graduation ceremony. We take selling tickets very seriously. Because we will not be able to give each student all the tickets they may want, we ask students to limit their list of people that they might invite. This means that not everyone will be able to attend. Typically we can accommodate many family members at our Baccalaureate Service; therefore, please feel free to invite everyone to that service. The Graduation Ceremony is typically live streamed and videoed for those that cannot attend. This can be found at Hallco.org and more information will come closer to graduation time

What is Cap and Gown Attire?

East Hall High School students are asked to wear Cap and Gown attire during the Senior Baccalaureate Service and the Graduation Ceremony. Gowns will be black with gold on sleeve. What do students wear?

Female students: Female students are asked to wear a dress (color of their choosing as it is not visible under the graduation gown). Hair can be worn up or down. Shoes can be color of choice. However, we do ask that female students practice walking in their shoes should they choose to wear high heels as they will be walking up and down stairs as well as walking across a stage at the graduation ceremony. No tennis shoes or to denim to be worn.

Male students: Male students are asked to wear dark pants, dark shoes, dark tie (the tie may be a bowtie or regular tie), dark socks, and a white collared dress shirt. Their pants would be visible under their gown. They do not have to be black pants/tie/shoes, but we do ask that they be dark. No tennis shoes or denim to be worn.

Graduation Caps: It is the policy of East Hall High School that students are NOT to decorate their graduation cap. This provides unity at our ceremony. It also helps maintain the formality of this wonderful event.

How do I order a Cap and Gown?

These are ordered from Jostens. A Jostens representative will come to school to not only take orders and share information, but also receive orders and payments. Paperwork for ordering a Cap and Gown and cover for diplomas is given out to Seniors early in the School year. This allows them to order these items along with other items of their choosing. Should a student plan to participate by walking at the graduation ceremony, they must order cap/gown/diploma cover at minimum. Because our gowns are custom made, we cannot wait until the last minute to order them. Typically, we order them in October of the senior year.
